Total Income for the month of May 2023 was above budget by \$5,469 due primarily to a large annual trust distribution from the Fred Riddle Trust, which in the future will become an annual distribution to the operating budget. Offering income was \$5,576 above budget. Total income YTD through May is above 2022 total income by \$175. Total expenses for May were below budget by \$2,254. Total Net Gain for May was \$9,292 and YTD gain was \$9,605. May YTD gain was below 2022 by \$(2,089) and \$1,762 above budget YTD. The Capital Campaign reached its goal of raising the \$45,000 borrowed from the endowment fund and the full \$45,000 has now been repaid in full. No interest or earnings were due in addition to the \$45,000 since the fund actually experienced a loss in value for the borrowed period. Note that a Balance Sheet comparative of 2022 and 2023 account balances through May has been included again this month (see above). Thank you for your continuing financial support of Redeemer's mission.
