Pastor Mariah will begin work at Redeemer on Monday, August 21. She will lead services at Redeemer and Grace on Sunday, August 27th.

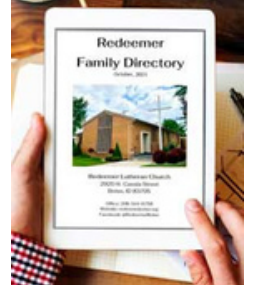

For August and Septembers MOM, our chosen charity is the Corpus Christi House. Here is some information about this worthy group:

Corpus Christi House. — We are Boise's only year-round day shelter. Our mission is to ease the burden of being homeless. We provide a place for people to get out of the weather, take a shower, wash their laundry, pick up mail, use the phone, eat, and be part of a community. We believe that each person is made in the image and likeness of God deserving of respect and human dignity.

Corpus Christi House in Boise, Idaho is a daytime drop-in homeless shelter that comes out of the tradition of Dorothy Day and her Catholic Worker movement and has expanded with participation and support from local churches of various denominations. We are a 501 (c)(3) nonprofit corporation whose mission is to serve the homeless.

Total expenses for June were below budget by \$2,393. Total Net Gain for June was \$1,718 and YTD gain was \$11,323. June YTD gain was below 2022 by \$(2,503) and \$1,911 above budget YTD.
